

Additional Testing for Post Secondary

After you have completed your OCAS and/or OUAC application you may receive information from prospective (schools you applied to) schools concerning tests or assessments that you need to complete.

Taking a test through the “Prospective School”?

1. Log in to account provided by school (via email)
2. **Decide whether you will book the test to be taken at the school or virtually**
3. If schools don't provide a virtual option, you may use a remote testing location
4. Book date and time for test
5. Make payment as necessary
6. Pay attention to deadlines (book in advance)
7. Look at sample questions

Taking a test at a “Remote Test Centre”

1. Contact the Remote Test Center that you would like to use and book a test date and time (have information as to what test you will be writing and what school it is needed for)
2. Make sure to get all the Remote Test Center information that you will need when booking test using your online account
3. Log in to account provided by prospective school
4. Book your required test and identify that you will be using a remote location
5. Provide the Remote Test Center Information (see below as example)
6. Note: there will be an additional fee to cover costs for proctoring the test
